SUE TO LEGALIZE GARAGE UNDER GRANT PK. LAND

A friendly test suit challenging the right of the park district to construct an underground parking garage beneath Grant park was filed yesterday in Circuit court. The Illinois Supreme court eventually will be asked to rule on the question thru an appeal. The aim is to clear away all legal tangles before construction begins.

Attorneys said a favorable court ruling on the question was necessary before revenue bonds could be sold to finance the construction. The plan is to build a two level underground lot beneath the park in a section extending from Randolph st. to Mongoe st.
